Jewel Box – BOM for December 2012 *This is a 'deconstructed block... you will return 2 four-patch blocks and 2 HSTdo not sew any of these to each other!!! A surprise awaits you if you are the winner.*


Materials for the half square triangle (HST)

- 1. We have provided a black 6" square
- 2. You provide bright, high contrast jewel tone 6" square

Directions:

- 1. Cut a 6" square of your bright fabric (FIG 1)
- 2. Draw a diagonal cutting line AND draw a sewing line 1/4" on either side of it (FIG 2)
- 3. Layer the black and the bright, right sides together
- 4. Stitch on the two $\frac{1}{4}$ " lines
- 5. Cut on the line in between the 2 sewing lines
- 6. Iron toward the black (you will have 2 identical blocks (FIG 3)
- 7. DO NOT TRIM (THE WINNER WILL TRIM THESE TO FIT HER 4 PATCHES)

In order to keep the blocks standard, please draw the sewing lines with your cutting ruler rather than depending on your ¼" foot. Thanks so much



Materials for one 4-patch block

In order to keep the blocks standard, please draw the sewing lines with your cutting ruler rather than depending on your $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot. Thanks so much

- 1. We have provided a black 6" square
- 2. You will provide two (2) different jewel toned scraps 3"x6"

Directions:

1. Draw a cutting line down the middle of the 6" black square **AND** draw a sewing line 1/4" on either side of it (FIG 1)

- 2. Cut on the middle line and layer your 3 x 6" jewel tones and blacks, right sides together
- 3. Sew lengthwise on the 6" side, press toward the black (FIG 2)
- 4. Cut in half at 3 inches (FIG 3) (now you have 2 two patches that are identical)
- Repeat steps with 2nd jewel tone scrap (FIG 3 shows both colors)
- 5. Now arrange and sew two 4-patches alternating the colors in opposite corners.
- 6. You should have 2 identical 4 patch blocks (FIG 5)
